

Statement of Ambassador Khusrav Noziri, ECO Secretary General at the 12th Session of the Islamic Conference of Tourism Ministers of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) 2 June 2024, Khiva, Uzbekistan

The Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) aims to enhance its Member States' economies through sustainable development. The region, with a population of over 500 million and a GDP of nearly 2.5 trillion USD, has immense tourism potential. Hosting 86 UNESCO World Heritage sites, including ancient Khiva, it attracted around 80 million visitors last year.

ECO plans to host the Third ECO Conference and Exhibition on Health Tourism in Iran this year. Additionally, we can collaborate on promoting ziyarah (religious tourism) in the ECO region, which boasts numerous madrasahs, mosques and social complexes significant in the spread of Islam.

The ECO's main goal is to achieve regional prosperity by expanding trade and investment ties among the Member States. I believe that tourism can play a significant role in achieving this goal by creating jobs, generating income and promoting cultural exchange.
