







GLOBAL TEMPERATURE RISE (1880 – 2020)







CLIMATE CHANGE IMPACTS OF TURKEY





A large part of Turkey is located in the dry summer subtropical Mediterranean climate zone. Therefore, Turkey is among medium-high risk countries in terms of both present climate, climate change and variability, and future climate, considering that Mediterranean Basin has been indicated as one of the most vulnerable regions in the world to the impacts of climate change (IPCC, 2007).





TURKEY/ TEMPERATURE PROJECTIONS








TURKEY/PRECIPITATION PROJECTIONS





CLIMATE CHANGE NEGOTIATIONS



Turkey ratified;

- **➤ UNFCC in** 2004,
- **≻Kyoto Protocol in** 2009
- Turkey accepted Paris Agreement in 2015, signed in 2015, but not ratified yet.
- > Turkey submitted its INDC in 2015.
- ➤ INDC: Up to 21% reduction in GHG emissions from the Business as Usual (BAU) level by 2030.






Local Climate Change Action Plan (LCCAP) Legislation


