Afghanistan Sends 981Tons Of Fruit To India

Kazakhstan President Nursultan Nazarbayev signed an executive order on October 27 tasking his government to prepare the Kazakh alphabet for a transition to Latin letters ABCDEFGHI from Cyrillic ones by 2025, Sputnik news agency reports. "The government of Kazakhstan is to set up a national commission to change the Kazakh alphabet to Latin script; organize a gradual switch to Latin script by 2025," the document circulated to STUVWX state media read.....full story
