Iran's trade surplus hits \$29b in 2016: UNCTAD



Iran's trade balance registered a \$29 billion surplus in 2016, Tasnim reported on Friday citing the "2017 handbook of statistics" report published by the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). According to the report, the country's total foreign trade stood at \$109 billion, of which \$69 billion was related to exports. The Islamic Republic also exported about \$10.202 billion worth of services while the total value of services Iran traded with the world was estimated at \$24.896 billion. Based on the UNCTAD report, Iran accounted for 0.34 percent of the world's total \$32.136 trillion trade in 2016. It put Iran's real ...full story

Turkish economy forecasted to grow 9.2 pct in Q3

Turkey is expected to grow 9.2 percent in the third quarter of this year, a panel of economists said Friday. A group of 17 experts questioned by Anadolu Agency projected the figure ahead of Monday's announcement of the third quarter's gross domestic product (GDP). Among the economists' expectations, the highest growth forecast for the third quarter of this year was 11.1 percent, while the lowest was 7.2 percent. Economists also forecasted that Turkey would see annual growth of 6 percent at the end of 2017, with the highest forecast at 6.7 percent and the lowest at 5.1 percent....full story

Turkmen GDP grows significantly since early 2017

Turkmenistan's GDP grew by 6.5 percent in January-November 2017, the country's Deputy Prime Minister Gochmyrat Myradov said at a meeting of the Cabinet of Ministers, Turkmenistan State News Agency reported Dec. 9. Turkmenistan's GDP rose in industry by 5.8 percent, in construction - by 1.4 percent, in transport and communications sector - by 10.9 percent, in trade - by 9.6 percent, in agriculture - by 5.1 percent, and in services sector - by 8.9 percent. In January-November 2017, the growth rate of production reached 6.4 percent, as compared to the same period of 2016......full story

Uzbekistan produces 8.38m tonnes of wheat & 2.93m tonnes of cotton – President



Uzbekistan produced about 8.38 million tonnes of wheat and over 2.93 million tonnes of cotton in 2017, the President of Uzbekistan Shavkat Mirziyoyev said at the Congress of Agriculture Workers of Uzbekistan on 9 December 2017. Uzbek leader underlined that the country produced 12,450 tonnes of cocoons, 318,000 tonnes of rice, 23 million tonnes of fruits and vegetables, as well as 13 million tones of meat and milk products. President said that over 160,000 farmers operate in Uzbekistan. Number of multiprofile farms rose by 45% in last...full story
