I- General Cooperation in the field of Energy

- (a) Exchange of information on energy resources of the member countries;
- (b) Exchange of information on the policies, laws and rules for the regulation and development of energy resources of the member countries;
- (c) Identification of the areas of cooperation for the public and private sectors in the development of the energy resources of the member countries.
- (d) Identification of areas in which transfer of technology in the energy sector can take place among the member countries.
- (e) Cooperation (i.e. Exportation, Exchange of information etc.) in the field of petro-chemicals, joint venture possibilities.
- (f) Cooperation in the fields of natural gas pipeline.
- (g) Cooperation in the fields of energy raw materials, mines and minerals.
- (h) Cooperation in transportation of crude oil by sea.

II- Possible Applications of Cooperation in the field of Energy

- (a) Cooperation for application of nuclear energy in agricultural activities.
- (b) Establishment of a tripartite consortium for the production of electro-mechanical equipments.
- (c) Project on inter-connection of power systems.
- (d) Utilization of idle capacities of related factories in the field of energy.
- (e) Exportation of crude oil and natural gas by Islamic Republic of Iran to Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Republic of Turkey.
- (f) Export of petroleum products surpluses from Islamic Republic of Iran to Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Republic of Turkey.

III- Consultation and Training in the field of Energy

- (a) Identification and utilization of consultancy services available in the member countries in the energy sector (e.g. oil exploration & renewable energy

resources, energy conservation).

- (b) Identification of academic centres of excellence in the field of energy and grant of scholarships on reciprocal basis;
- (c) Cooperation in the field of research in energy (e.g. geophysics, petrochemicals transfer of technology, supply/demand estimates of different resources of energy, visits of research centers of member countries).
- (d) Identification of focal points through which research publications in the field of energy can be exchanged.
- (e) Arranging of seminars, meetings and conferences in the energy sector within framework of ECO.
- (f) Invitation of Islamic Republic of Iran to Islamic Republic of Pakistan and Republic of Turkey to send graduate students for participation in energy economics course in the next academic year.
