# <u>Report</u> <u>Inaugural Session</u>

29<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Regional Planning Council (RPC) of the Economic Cooperation Organization (ECO) was held on 17–20 December 2018 at the ECO Secretariat, Tehran. Sectoral Committees' Meetings were also held on the sidelines of the 29<sup>th</sup> RPC Meeting.

2. The Meeting was attended by the delegations from ECO Member States namely the Islamic Republic of Afghanistan, Republic of Azerbaijan, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Republic of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Republic of Turkey, Turkmenistan and Republic of Uzbekistan, as well as the delegation of ECO Secretariat. The representatives of the Turkish Cypriot State also attended the Meeting in the capacity of Observer. The representatives of ECO Specialized Agencies, Regional Institutions and Affiliated Bodies also participated in the Meeting. The list of participants is placed at *Annexure-IV*.

#### Agenda Item No.1

#### (i) <u>Opening remarks</u>

3. The ECO Secretary General H.E. Dr. Hadi Soleimanpour welcomed the participants to the meeting. The Secretary General especially expressed gratitude to the distinguished delegates from their respective capitals for participation in the 29<sup>th</sup> Regional Planning Council (RPC) Meeting. He dilated upon the role of the RPC as entrusted by the Council of Ministers (CoM) inter-alia review past programmes by evaluating success and shortcomings; and proposed future programmes of action in line with the objectives of the Organization as laid down in the founding documents as well as ECO Vision 2025. The Secretary General emphasized upon the importance of this particular session of the council in turning ECO into a project-oriented organization based upon the profound desire of the ECO Member States. He appreciated and highlighted the efforts of ECO Member States and institutions in realizing the Work Programme approved by 28<sup>th</sup> RPC held in Islamabad in 2017.

4. The ECO Secretary General presented directorate wise overview encompassing notable achievements during 2018 and steps for further improvement. He emphasized upon having an agreed approach to implement ECO Trade Agreement (ECOTA) to enhance trade in region. The Secretary General acknowledged the visible progress in the area of transport and communications in 2018 and highlighted that the Dushanbe Communiqué renewed ECO's commitment to fully implement the Transit Transport Framework Agreement (TTFA). He specifically mentioned the progress achieved in the "ECO Plan of Action for Energy/Petroleum Cooperation" for the period 2019-2023 and expressed hope that the envisaged new Plan of Action for the project will be approved by the 4<sup>th</sup> ECO Ministerial Meeting on Energy. The ECO Secretary General highlighted ECO's collaboration with UNIDO in establishment of ECO Clean Energy Centre (CECECO)

and expressed satisfaction on completion of its Preparatory Phase this year. He further mentioned about different projects being pursued by ECO Secretariat in the fields of Tourism, Environment, Agriculture and Minerals. A copy of the detailed statement is placed at <u>Annexure-III.</u>

## **First Plenary Session**

#### (ii) <u>Election of the Chairman</u>

5. As per ECO's rules and procedures His Excellency Mr. Nematullo Emomzoda, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of the Republic of Tajikistan was elected as the Chairman of the 29<sup>th</sup> RPC Meeting.

At the outset Mr. Nematullo Emomzoda welcomed the participants to the 6. meeting and expressed gratitude to the ECO Secretary General for comprehensive statement encompassing achievement of ECO during 2018. The Chairman expressed sincere gratitude to the Member States for showing faith in electing him as the Chairman of the Council. He further stated that Tajikistan being Chair of CoM since April, attaches great importance to the further expansion and deepening of multifaceted relations with the member countries as well as strengthening its activities. The Chairman highlighted the importance of RPC in preparing the programme of activities of Organization for 2019 as well as achieving the goals and objectives of the ECO vision 2025. He expressed confidence that experts participating in sectoral meetings will make efforts to prepare and implement the work programme aimed at expansion of regional cooperation and meeting the interests of the people of Member States. The Chairman expressed gratitude to the ECO Secretariat for making excellent arrangements for the meeting. He wished fruitful discussion during various Working Committee meetings with concrete outcome thus providing future course of action for 2019. A copy of his statement is placed at Annexure-III.
