

**Main metadata descriptions:**

1	Population (Thousand)	Member of all private settled and institutional households whose usual place of residence is located in the country of NSO at the time of enumeration of all private unsettled households. Foreign diplomatic crops are excluded. Inwards and outwards.
2	Annual Growth Rate of Population (%)	Population increases or decreases, at the same rate over each unit of time. The change of population is due to fertility, mortality and migration.
3	Life Expectancy at Birth by Sex (Year)	The number of years a new born infant would expect to live if prevailing patterns of mortality at the time of its birth were to stay the same throughout its life.
4	Population by Major Age Groups (%)	population by five years age group
5	Median Age of Population (Year)	The age which divides the population into two equal groups in number.
6	Total Fertility Rate	The average number of children that would be born alive to a women during her lifetime, if she were to bear children at each age in accordance with prevailing age-specific fertility rates.
7	Dependency Ratio (%)	Obtained from dividing the population of not economically active age group by active population times 100.
8	Total Labor Force (Thousand)	The sum of the employed and the unemployed population measured for a short reference period is equivalent to the labour force, also known as the current economically active population.
9	Total Employment (Thousand)	All people aged 10 or over who according to the definition of work have worked for at least one hour during the reference week or have temporarily left their job for one reason or another, are reckoned as employed.
10	Unemployment Rate (%)	The ratio of the unemployed population to the active population (employed and unemployed)

40	Total Heads of Cattle, Sheep and Goat (Thousand)	<p>Agricultural holdings: All agricultural activities run by a single management form an "agricultural production unit" which is an "agricultural holding".</p> <p>Holding of livestock: Each of agricultural holdings that has at least 2 heads of small livestock (sheep and goat )or one head of large livestock(cow, buffalo &amp; camel) is named as holdings with livestock.</p> <p><b>Total</b> heads of cattle: Total male and female cow at the age of under two years old and two years old and over on the day of enumeration.</p> <p><b>Total</b> heads of sheep and goat: Total male and female sheep and goat at the age of under one year old and one year old and over on the day of enumeration</p>
41	Production of Meat, Milk and Egg (Thousand Tons, Million)	<p><b>Production of Meat:</b> Data may be collected by conducting slaughter houses survey. This data correlates with the amount of carcass weight produced in slaughter houses during the last 365 days.</p> <p><b>Production of Milk :</b>As of holdings enumeration date, the amount of milk produced from cow, sheep and goat during the last 365 days</p> <p><b>Production of Egg :</b> As of holdings enumeration date, the amount of egg contains edible and shell less eggs produced in laying poultry farms in a year</p>

47	University Enrollment	University enrolment refers to the person that based on approved regulations is admitted for the first time and has been recruited in one of higher education institutes (such as research centres and universities).
48	Number of University Instructors	Number of university instructors includes instructors of universities, higher education centres.
49	Student-Instructor Ratio in Universities (Number of students per instructor)	Student-Instructor Ratio in Universities normally results from dividing the sum of number of university students at different levels of universities and higher education establishments and higher education centres by the sum of instructors from universities and higher education centres.
