## ЭЫҰ мүше мемлекеттері Сыртқы істер министрлерінің 27-ші отырысындағы баяндама

Dear Excellences, Esteemed colleagues, Distinguished ladies and gentlemen,

At the outset, let me express my sincere gratitude to our good friend and colleague, the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Mr. Jeyhun Bayramov, for a warm hospitality and excellent organization of today's meeting in beautiful Shusha – the "crown of Karabakh", symbol of strength and unity of your nation.

Taking this opportunity, I also congratulate our hosts on the occasion of the upcoming 32nd Anniversary of the Restoration of Azerbaijan's Independence (18 October).

In reaffirming my country's full support for Azerbaijan's sovereignty and territorial integrity, I underscore that joining efforts to ensure peace and stability in our wider neighbourhood is among Kazakhstan's top foreign policy priorities.

Kazakhstan attaches **utmost importance** to all activities aimed at building lasting bridges of brotherhood and friendship between ECO states.

Kazakhstan expresses its deep concern over the serious aggravation of the Palestinian-Israeli conflict, which has caused numerous casualties and deaths among civilians.

We call on the parties to seek **political tools** to resolve the situation **peacefully** and not resort to actions that could lead to **further escalation** of the situation not only between the two sides, but also in **the Middle East as a whole**.

## Dear friends,

Today I look forward to our discussions and exchange of ideas on ensuring a **brighter future** as partners.

Our Organization encompasses an area of **7 million sq. km.** and has a combined population of **over 300 million** people.

Given the political influence and growing economic potential of our Member States, Kazakhstan believes the ECO can and should play a greater strategic role in regional affairs.

In this regard, I would like to highlight several promising areas for our closer interaction and

reiterate Kazakhstan's readiness to work for a common good of all ECO Member States.

**FIRST**, despite geopolitical turmoil and multifaceted challenges, in 2022 our combined trade grew almost **40**% and exceeded **16 billion dollars**.

However, there is still untapped potential for intensifying intra-regional cooperation in the coming years, namely through ambitious infrastructure and transportation projects.

To this end, Kazakhstan is actively involved in building cross-border hubs that take advantage of our geostrategic location on the crossroads of five international railways and eight automobile transit corridors.

We are successfully operating the **International Centre for Industrial Cooperation** on the Kazakh-Uzbek border.

A similar **complex** will be built in **Kyrgyzstan**, and agreements to create **distribution centres** and **grain terminals** have

been reached with **Turkmenistan** and **Tajikistan**.

Kazakhstan currently exports more than **500** items of **food products** to about **70** countries, including all Central Asian states, Türkiye, Iran, and Afghanistan.

By becoming a **logistics hub**, our country can play a vital role in ensuring **food security** in our regions.

We are **ready to explore technological and regulatory aspects** of increased collaboration in this sphere.

<u>SECOND</u>, Kazakhstan sees emerging opportunities in **infrastructure cooperation**.

New, more efficient and sustainable transport routes are being formed between China and Europe via Central Asia and the Caucasus.

At present, Kazakhstan and its international partners are giving priority to removing bottlenecks along the Trans-Caspian International Transport Route.

Our plan is to systematically expand cargo traffic through this route and bring it to **500 thousand containers** per year **by 2030**.

Moreover, Kazakhstan is committed to further diversifying transport routes in the North-South direction.

By utilizing the **Kazakhstan-Turkmenistan-Iran** (*KTI*) railway, our countries can increase cargo flows by up to **10 million tons** per year.

These are encouraging figures in light of the wide use of railways in ECO Member States' transportation systems (*up to* 80% of freight and more than 50% of passenger traffic).

The **continued expansion** and **integration** of transport corridors can thus ensure sustainable economic progress for all ECO members.

We encourage all interested parties to join Kazakhstan and our partners in implementing mutually beneficial infrastructure projects.

<u>THIRD</u>, as the ECO's "Vision 2025" road map is gradually nearing completion, we propose to include in its successor document priorities like IT, artificial intelligence, and creative

## economy.

In particular, Kazakhstan's **new economic policy**, announced in September by President Kassym-Jomart Tokayev, is focused on creating conditions for growth in **manufacturing**, as well as **science** and **technology** sectors.

My country also plans to become one of the **IT** powerhouses and boost exports of its domestic hi-tech sector to **500 million dollars** by the end of this year.

I invite member states to explore opportunities with the "Astana Hub" international technopark, for example, through possible cooperation with the ECO's Science Foundation and Educational Institute.

**FOURTH**, in its capacity as Chair of the **Conference on Interaction and Confidence Building Measures in Asia** (*CICA*), Kazakhstan stands ready to assist in fostering economic interaction between the ECO and CICA.

We believe **relevant joint projects** could potentially focus on the aforementioned fields of

transportation and logistics, energy, and digital technologies, as well as **agriculture**, **finance** and **tourism**.

**NOW**, I turn to the **situation in Afghanistan**.

In the past year, Kazakhstan's Government provided humanitarian and financial aid to the Afghan people within the framework of the Islamic Organization for Food Security.

Furthermore, Kazakhstan's initiative to establish in Almaty the UN Regional Centre for Sustainable Development for Central Asia and Afghanistan will provide long-term impetus in this direction.

I call upon ECO Member States to **join Kazakhstan** in mitigating the humanitarian crisis in Afghanistan and providing necessary assistance to its long-suffering people.

<u>LAST but not least</u>, we see increased public demand to address climate change.

Our country is pursuing a bold strategy to reach **carbon neutrality** by 2060 and is ready to **share its expertise**.

Kazakhstan also fully shares concerns of ECO Member States over **extreme droughts**,

floods, heat waves, and forest fires in our region.

Of course, we constantly discuss our regional threats and challenges on various platforms and forums.

However, the further consolidation of our joint efforts is still an acute and long-overdue task ahead of us.

With this in mind, Kazakhstan initiated convening of a Regional Climate Summit under the UN auspices in 2026.

We would **warmly welcome** the participation of all ECO Member States in the upcoming important event.

## Dear friends,

I am confident that our bilateral and collective cooperation in various fields will contribute to reaching universally accepted **sustainable development goals** and **greater global economic competitiveness** within the ECO space.

Kazakhstan is ready to work together with

all Member States to achieve these noble ends.
