1.	The Council appreciated the confirmation of the ECO Member States on hosting the 6 th Ministerial Meeting on Finance/Economy (ECO-MM on F/E) preceded by the SOM in 2024 which could not been held in 2022 and 2023 due to lack of quorum. The Council tasked the Secretariat to pursue through diplomatic channel with Member States for their offer to host the 6 th ECO-MM on F/E during 2024.The Council further requested the Membership to prepare for the meeting, once it is announced.	
2.	The Council took note of the fact that the 5 th ECO Ministerial Meeting on Commerce and Foreign Trade (ECO-MM on CFT) has not taken place for the last seven years. The meeting was offered by Türkiye during the 33 rd RPC to host in 2023 but it could not be held. The Council observed that in order to reach a satisfactory level of progress on various ECO initiatives and activities, the successful organization of both the ECO-Ministerial Meeting on Commerce & Foreign Trade (ECO MM on CFT) and the ECOTA Cooperation Council Meetings is essential. The Council thanked the Republic of Türkiye for their offer to host the 5 th ECO-MM on CFT) to be preceded by a Senior Officials Group Meeting only after the realization of 9 th ECOTA Cooperation Council Meeting.	
3.	The Council took note that the 9 th ECOTA Cooperation Council Meeting (ECOTA CCM) could not be held in 2023, although during 33 rd RPC Pakistan offered to hosted it. The Secretariat informed the Council that the report of the research study, titled "Impediments in Implementation of ECO's Trade Tools and Measures to Resolve" was shared with the ECOTA Parties for their views/comments. 7.	The Council recalled that the 1 st Meeting of the Experts of Tax Administration, on 26-28 2014 in Tehran had finalized the following three draft documents on ECO Tax Cooper namely:	

- a) The Charter for Establishment of ECO Tax Administration Cooperation Society (ECOTAX);
- b) ECO Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in Taxation and Related Matters; and.
- c) Agreement on the Exchange of Information in Tax Matters.

The Council further recalled that the Secretariat was tasked by the 33rd RPC to:

- a) Host the 2nd Meeting of the ECO Heads of Tax Administration, once it receives feedback on three basic draft documents in 2023,
- b) Organize a *Preliminary Discussion Meeting*, as requested by I.R of Pakistan, to review the draft agreements before scheduling the 2nd Meeting of the ECO Heads of Tax Administration.

The Secretariat apprised the Council that views/comments were received from the Republic of Azerbaijan, the Islamic Republic of Iran, the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Islamic Republic of Pakistan.

The Secretariat apprised the Council that the *Preliminary Discussion Meeting* was hosted by the Secretariat on August 1, 2023, virtually, under the chairmanship of the Republic of Azerbaijan, to review/develop Consensus on Drafts of Three Tax Related Cooperation draft documents. The meeting was attended by the delegations from Azerbaijan (Chair), Iran, Pakistan, Tajikistan, Türkiye, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan. The Meeting unanimously decided to drop out the two documents i.e. '*Draft ECO Memorandum of Understanding on Cooperation in Taxation and Related Matters*' and '*Draft Agreement on the Exchange of Information in Tax Matters among ECO Member States*', and decided to pursue only one document titled '*Draft Charter of the ECO Tax Administration Cooperation Society (ECOTAX)*'. The Meeting reviewed the text of '*Draft Charter of the ECO Tax Administration Cooperation Society (ECOTAX)*', Article by Article, and also deliberated on the comments of the Member States on the text of the charter in each Article. The Meeting added a new Article # 10 with the title 'Entry into Force'.

The Meeting also deliberated the draft Agenda prepared by the Secretariat and finalized the Agenda for the '2nd Meeting of ECO Heads of Tax Administration' scheduled to be held in


