Agenda Item No. 1

Inauguration of the Meeting

Mr. Aziz Abdukhakimov, Honourable Minister of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change of the Republic of Uzbekistan as the host of the Ministerial Meeting will make his welcoming remarks and preside over the event.

Agenda Item No. 3

Adoption of the Agenda

- 6. The Secretariat in cooperation with the ECO Institute for Environmental Science and Technology (ECO-IEST), has reviewed the former Framework Plan of Action in the light of "ECO Vision 2025", recent global and regional environmental developments, and rapidly evolving global environmental agenda. As an outcome of this process, the draft of the ECO Cooperation Framework on the Environment and its annexes have been developed and disseminated to the ECO Member States vide ECO Secretariat's Note Verbale No. EME/MM on Environment/2022/995 dated 7 July 2022.
- 7. It is to be recalled that the Informal Ministerial Meeting on Environment of the ECO Member States held on 9 December 2023 on the sidelines of COP28 in Dubai noted with appreciation the development of the new "ECO Cooperation Framework on the Environment" and its two Annexes. This meeting considered it as a long-term regional strategy that streamlines key priorities and action areas in the ECO Region for environmental cooperation in view of the rapidly evolving global environmental and climate agenda. The meeting thus recommended the subject Cooperation Framework for adoption by the decision-making bodies of ECO.



Agenda Item No. 7

High-Level Dialogue Platform on Environmental Cooperation: a way forward

- 8. The Informal Ministerial Meeting on Environment of the ECO Member States in Dubai on 9 December 2023 emphasized the importance of the High-Level Dialogue Platform on Environmental Cooperation, which was established in the course of the 26th Meeting of the ECO Council of Ministers (COM) held on 24 January 2023 in Tashkent, as a promising advisory mechanism involving academia and contributing to environmental sustainability in the ECO Region. The Informal Ministerial Meeting underscored that the subject Platform may find solutions to environmental challenges, explore ways to enhance cooperation on environment and determine the scope of regional collaboration in the ECO Region.
- 9. The honourable Ministers/Head of Delegations of the ECO Member States may wish to decide about how to organize the first meeting of this Platform.

Agenda Item No. 8

Endorsement of the "Joint Statement on Launching the Regional Initiative on Resource Efficiency, Sustainability, and Circular Economy in the ECO Region (RESCUE)"

- 10. The Secretariat in its Note Verbale No. EME/2024/936 dated 11 July 2024, and Note Verbale No. EME/2024/1207 dated 29 August 2024 shared the draft "Joint Statement on Launching the Regional Initiative on Resource Efficiency, Sustainability, and Circular Economy in the ECO Region (RESCUE)" with the Member States and requested any possible views on the draft by 9 September 2024.
- 11. The honourable Ministers/Head of Delegations may wish to endorse the subject document. It is due to be presented during the Ministerial Meeting on Circular Economy on 16 November 2024 as a non-binding document for joining by different stakeholders.
