The 1st Ministerial Meeting on Environment

Report

(*Tehran*, 13-15 *December* 2002)

The First ECO Ministerial Meeting on Environment was held in Tehran (Islamic Republic of Iran) on 15 December, 2002 and preceded by the Meeting of the Senior Officials (13-14 December, 2002). The delegations of all the ECO Member States: Islamic State of Afghanistan, Republic of Azerbaijan, Islamic Republic of Iran, Republic of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Islamic Republic of Pakistan, Republic of Tajikistan, Republic of Turkey, Turkmenistan and Republic of Uzbekistan participated in the meeting. The ECO Secretariat's delegation also attended the Meeting. The representatives of UNEP, UNESCAP, UNDP, UNIDO, ROPME and IDB were also present. The list of participants is attached (*Annex – I*).

Agenda Item No.1

Inauguration of the Meeting

- 2. The Meeting was inaugurated by His Excellency Seyed Mohammad Khatami, President of the Islamic Republic of Iran. The text of his official opening speech is attached (*Annex-II*).
- 3. H.E. <u>We</u> the Ministers of Environment and Heads of Delegation meeting in Tehran, Islamic Republic of Iran on 15 December 2002, on the occasion of the First ECO Ministerial Meeting on Environment, held in pursuance of the October 2002 ECO Summit in Istanbul and the concern of the ECO member states on the protection of the environment in the region,

<u>Recalling</u> the article 2(m) of the Treaty of Izmir, the basic charter of ECO, and Istanbul Declaration 2002 adopted at the 7th Summit as well as the Stockholm Declaration of the United Nations Conference on the Human Environment, the Rio Declaration of the United Nations Conference on Environment and Sustainable Development and the Johannesburg Declaration on Sustainable Development along with the "Plan of Implementation" of the United Nations World Summit on Sustainable Development held in September 2002,

<u>**Deeply**</u> convinced that promotion of regional cooperation in the field of environment is essential.

<u>Aware</u> and concerned about the trends of environmental degradation and pollution in the ECO region,

<u>Cognizant</u> of the fact that accelerated formulation and implementation of environmental action plans require political will and legal commitments,

<u>Determined</u> to achieve significant success in combating environmental degradation in the ECO Region with active and full participation of all actors of the society, an aware and educated population, respect for ethical and spiritual values and cultural diversity,

<u>Agree</u> to initiate cooperation in the following fields in accordance with the Plan of Action, adopted at our meeting:

Taking note of the importance of the Human Environment, decide to cooperate in the harmonization of Environmental Standards, Environmentally Sound Technologies, Urban Environmental Management, and improving the Environmental Impact Assessment systems,

Recognizing the importance of preservation of Natural Environment, decide to cooperate in promoting the sustainable use of biological diversity including sustainable eco-tourism and conservation of wetlands and water bodies,

Acknowledging the need to protect the Marine Environment from any source of pollution, stress the need to establish Marine Pollution Emergency Response and Preparedness Centres(ERCs),

Underlining the importance of Environmental Education, Training, Research & Development, agree in principle on the establishment of an ECO Environmental College, joint training courses, scholarships, awards and promotion of public awareness,

Stressing the importance of Legal Framework in the field of Environment Development, underline the need to seek International Financial Assistance to establish ECO Environmental Fund,

<u>Decide</u> to establish a Working Group according to ECO procedure to prepare implementation plans for cooperation in the different fields of Environment, as mentioned in the adopted Plan of Action. The ECO Secretariat together with the relevant authorities in the member states and national focal points nominated by them should play supportive and coordinative role in the implementation of all actions identified in this plan. The Secretariat shall also seek arrangements with multilateral agencies which may be supportive to the organization in this regard.

Appreciating the urgent need to restructure the environmental institution in Afghanistan, the ECO member states, offer to assist to develop the requisite infrastructure for the establishment of an Environmental Protection Agency in Afghanistan.

<u>Agree</u> to submit to the ECO Secretariat bi-annually national progress report on the implementation of the Plan of Action which shall be integrated and circulated by the Secretariat to member states and submitted for the review by the Council of Permanent Representatives (CPR). The Secretariat shall also present an annual report on the status of implementation of the activities envisaged by the Plan of

Action to the meeting of the Regional Planning Council (RPC). The 2nd Ministerial meeting on Environment would review the implementation of the Plan of Action.

We express our sincere gratitude to His Excellency Seyed Mohammad Khatami, the Honourable President of the Islamic Republic of Iran, for his guidance, support and leadership and sparing his extremely valuable time to inaugurate the meeting.

We welcome the offer of the Ministry of Environment of the Republic of Turkey to host the Second ECO Ministerial Meeting on Environment during the year 2004.

We also express our gratitude to the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran for the warm hospitality extended to the delegations and appreciate the excellent arrangements made by the Department of Environment of the Islamic Republic of Iran and the ECO Secretariat for the 1st ECO Ministerial Meeting on Environment.
